Affinity-chromatography

Storage

Store at -20°C for one year. For short term storage and frequent use, store at 4°C for up to one month. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Name GSN

Function

Calcium-regulated, actin-modulating protein that binds to the plus (or barbed) ends of actin monomers or filaments, preventing monomer exchange (end-blocking or capping). It can promote

the assembly of monomers into filaments (nucleation) as well as sever filaments already formed (PubMed:19666512). Plays a role in ciliogenesis (PubMed:20393563).

Cellular Location

[Isoform 2]: Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton.

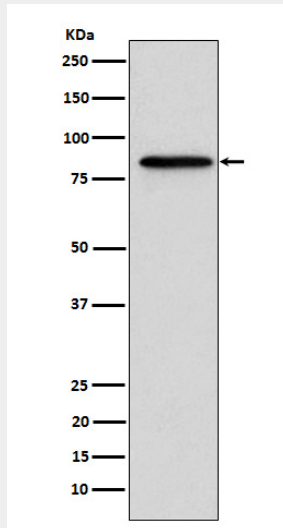
Tissue Location

Phagocytic cells, platelets, fibroblasts, nonmuscle cells, smooth and skeletal muscle cells
