Name CNN1

Function Thin filament-associated protein that is

implicated in the regulation and

modulation of smooth muscle contraction.

It is capable of binding to actin,

calmodulin, troponin C and tropomyosin. The interaction of calponin with actin inhibits the actomyosin Mg-ATPase activity

(By similarity).

Tissue Location Smooth muscle, and tissues containing

significant amounts of smooth muscle



Calponin Antibody - Images



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human normal breast tissue using AD80056 performed on the Abcarta® FAIP-30 Fully automated IHC platform. Tissue was fixed with formaldehyde at room temperature, antigen retrieval was by heat mediation with a Citrate buffer (pH6. 0). Samples were incubated with primary antibody (Ready-to-use) for 15 min at room temperature. AmpSeeTM Detection Systems Abcepta: AR005 was used as the secondary antibody.
