May be involved in processing of pneumocyte surfactant precursors. Secreted.

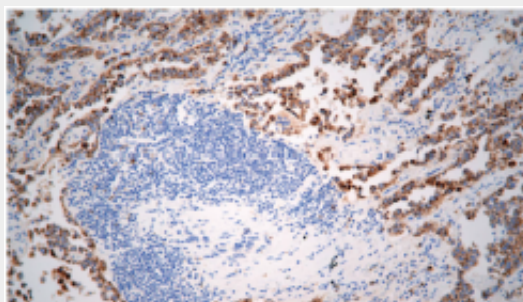

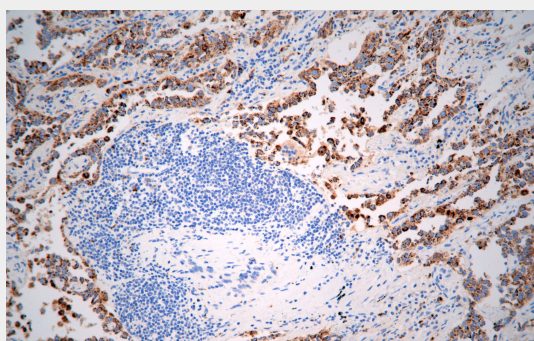

Lung adenocarcinoma



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human lung adenocarcinoma tissue using AD80102 performed on the Abcarta® FAIP-30 Fully automated IHC platform. Tissue was fixed with formaldehyde at room temperature, antigen retrieval was by heat mediation with a Citrate buffer (pH6.0). Samples were incubated with primary antibody (Ready-to-use) for 15 min at room temperature. AmpSee™ Detection Systems [Abcepta:AR005] was used as the secondary antibody.
