Transcription factor that binds to the CACCC box in the promoter of target genes such as HBB/beta

globin or NOV and activates their transcription (PubMed:21063504). Might be involved in transcriptional regulation by modulating the binding of the RARA nuclear receptor to RARE DNA elements (PubMed:28167758).

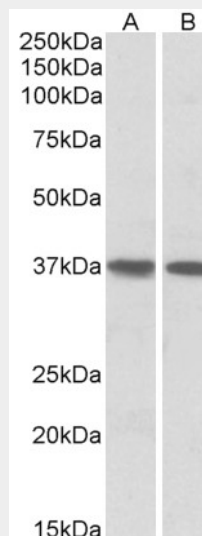
