Plays an essential role in heart function and development by regulating the organization and function of the sarcoplasmic reticulum in cardiomyocytes.

Endoplasmic reticulum membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein. Sarcoplasmic reticulum membrane {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q60870}; Multi-pass membrane protein. Note=Localizes to endoplasmic reticulum tubular network (PubMed:23969831). In cardiomyocytes, localizes to the junctional sarcoplasmic reticulum membrane which is closely tethered to the cell membrane and

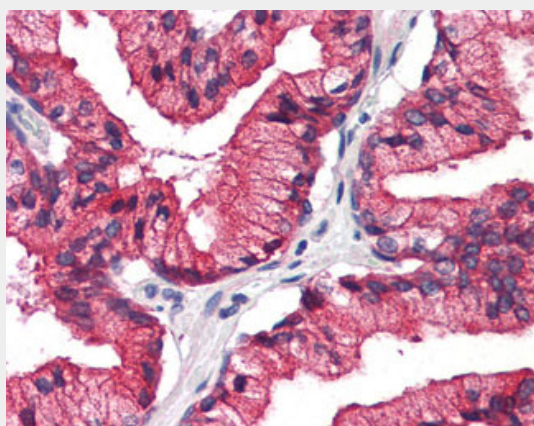
Expressed in heart (at protein level) (PubMed:32075961). Expressed in circumvallate papillae and testis (PubMed:16720576).
