Target/Specificity

This SRPR antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 453-480 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human SRPR.

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

Synonyms SRPR

Function Component of the signal recognition particle (SRP) complex receptor (SR) (PubMed:[16439358](#)). Ensures, in conjunction with the SRP complex, the correct targeting of the nascent secretory proteins to the endoplasmic reticulum membrane system (PubMed:[16675701](#), PubMed:[34020957](#)). Forms a guanosine 5'-triphosphate (GTP)-dependent complex with the SRP subunit SRP54 (PubMed:[34020957](#)). SRP receptor compaction and GTPase rearrangement drive SRP-mediated cotranslational protein translocation into the ER (PubMed:[34020957](#)).

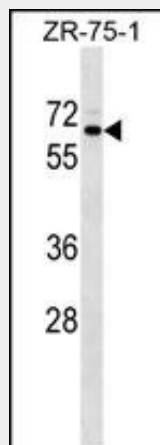

SRPR Antibody (C-term) - Background

The gene encodes a subunit of the endoplasmic reticulum signal recognition particle receptor that, in conjunction with the signal recognition particle, is involved in the targeting and translocation of signal sequence tagged secretory and membrane proteins across the endoplasmic reticulum. Alternative splicing

results in multiple transcript variants.
