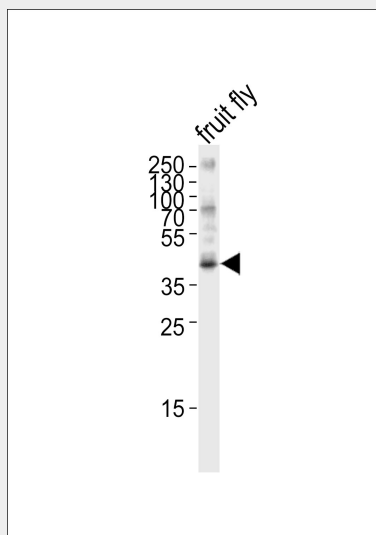

Western blot analysis of lysate from fruit fly, using BUB3 Antibody (Drosophila)(Cat. #AP20606a). AP20606a was diluted at 1:1000. A goat anti-rabbit IgG H&L(HRP) at 1:5000 dilution was used as the secondary antibody. Lysate at 35ug.
