This OXTR antibody is generated from a rabbit immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 348-380 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human OXTR.

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

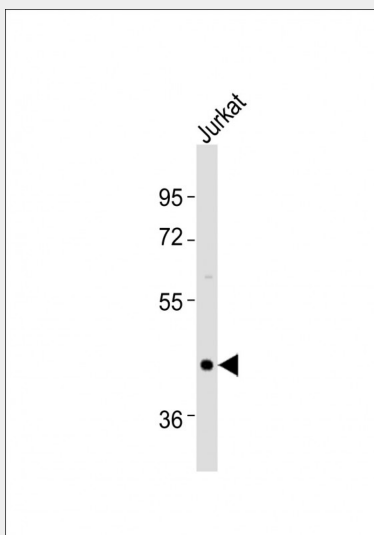

Anti-OXTR Antibody (C-term) at 1:1000 dilution + Jurkat whole cell lysates. Lysates/proteins at 20 µg per lane. Secondary Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG, (H+L), Peroxidase conjugated at 1/10000 dilution. Predicted band size : 43 kDa. Blocking/Dilution buffer: 5% NFD/MTBST.
