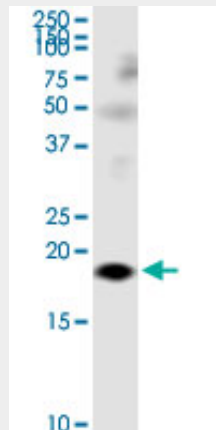

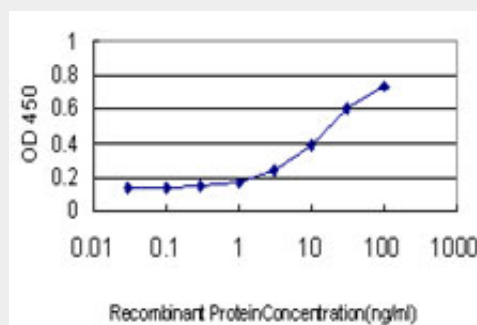

Detection limit for recombinant GST tagged LY86 is approximately 0.3ng/ml as a capture antibody.
